

2021-2022 Health and Safety Policies January 2, 2022

The Monroe Arts Center's highest priority is the health, wellness, and safety of all those who walk through our doors. In order to ensure your health and safety and that of all our guests and audiences, the Monroe Arts Center is reopening with the following guidelines under the guidance of the Green County Public Health Department.

All MAC Buildings

 All persons entering the Monroe Arts Center must wear a mask over their nose and mouth.

Gunderson Stiles Concert Hall

- All guests 5 years and older will be required to show proof of full vaccination with a
 physical vaccination card, a photograph of the card, or a digital vaccination record (with
 the last dose administered at least 14 days prior to the event) along with identification.
- Children under the age of 5 will be required to show a negative COVID-19 test taken within 72 hours.
- All guests will be required to wear a face mask over their nose and mouth at all times.
- There will be an empty seat on either side of each ticketed party.
- All performers and staff will be fully vaccinated.
- There will be no bar or snack sales.
- There will be no intermissions.
- Four NuCalgon I-Wave-R air purifiers have been installed in the Concert Hall HVAC system.
- The building will be sanitized between each usage.

Additionally, Performers will be required to;

- Performers will be required to show proof of full vaccination with a physical vaccination card, a photograph of the card, or a digital vaccination record (with the last dose administered at least 14 days prior to the event).
- Performers will be tested with a rapid test when they arrive onsite.
- Performers will be required to wear a mask over nose and mouth while inside the MAC Buildings, except for sound checks and during performance.

Events and Classes

All persons attending events that take place inside the MAC Buildings;

- All guests 5 years and older will be required to show proof of full vaccination with a
 physical vaccination card, a photograph of the card, or a digital vaccination record (with
 the last dose administered at least 14 days prior to the event) along with identification.
- Children under the age of 5 will be required to show a negative COVID-19 test taken within 72 hours.
- All guests will be required to wear a face mask over their nose and mouth at all times.

Meetings

All persons attending meetings that take place inside the MAC Buildings;

- All guests 5 years and older will be required to show proof of full vaccination with a physical vaccination card, a photograph of the card, or a digital vaccination record (with the last dose administered at least 14 days prior to the event) along with identification.
- Children under the age of 5 will be required to show a negative COVID-19 test taken within 72 hours.
- All guests will be required to wear a face mask over their nose and mouth at all times.
